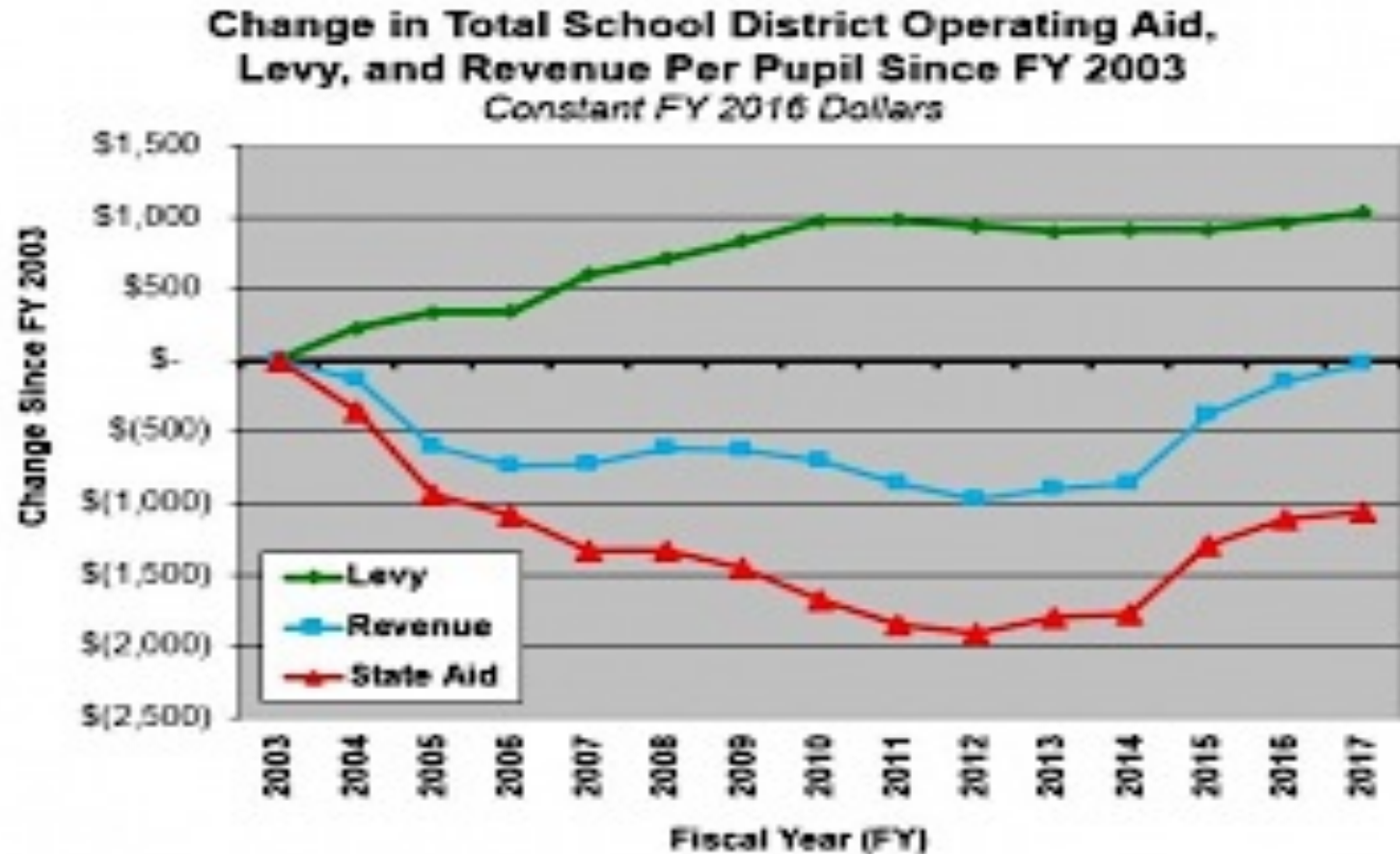

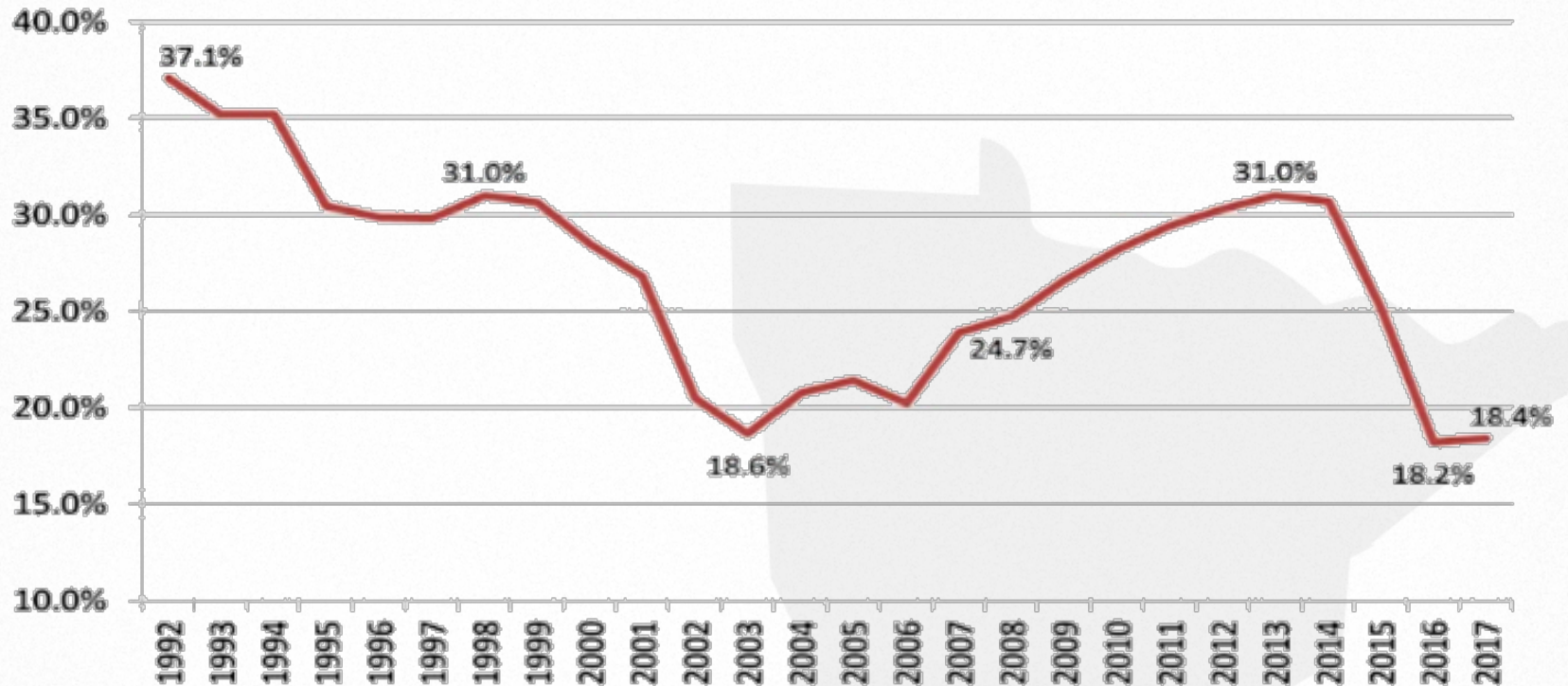

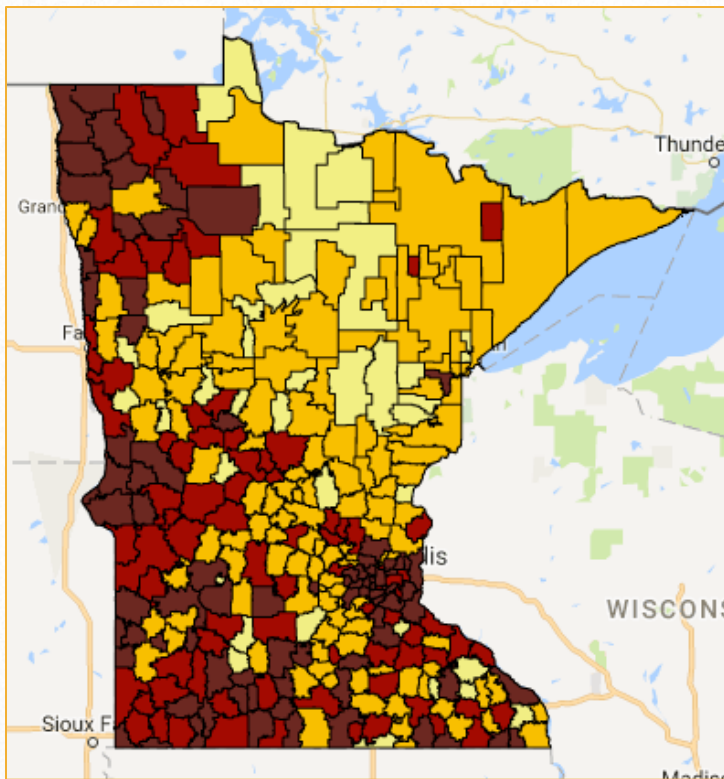
Funding Student Needs

Disparity – 95th to 5th

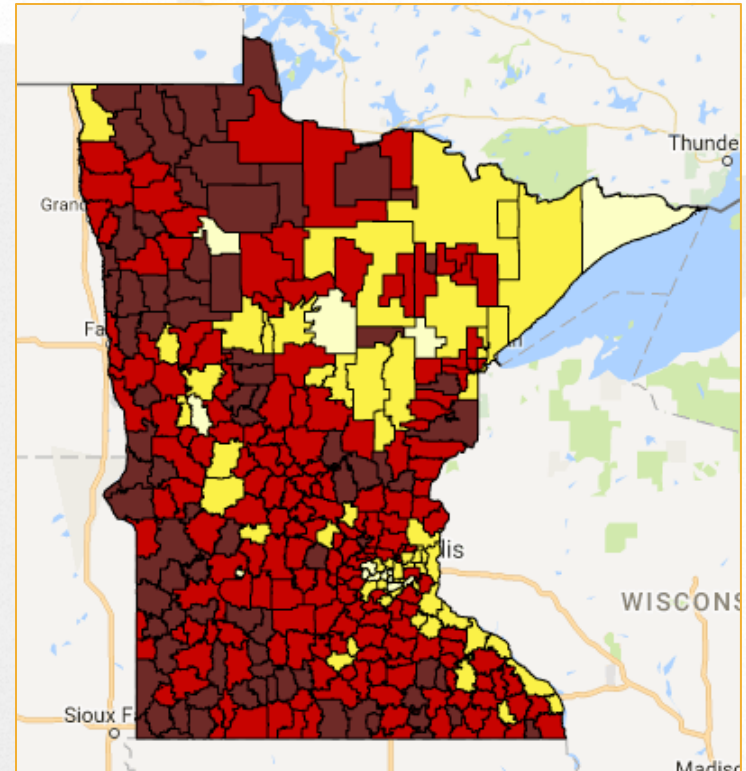


Current Referendum Picture

Going Beyond the Formula

Strategies to Consider:

- Increase Maximum Allowances for Board Approved Operating Referendum and Local Operating Revenue (LOR)
- Roll Board Approved Operating Referendum into LOR (\$724 or more) without loss of equalization
- Increase Referendum Allowances eligible for Tier II and III
- Increase Tier I-III Equalization Factors to expand eligibility
- Enhance Equalization for Districts with greater than 30% Seasonal Recreation Property
- Link Equalization Factors to average Referendum Market Value per student (RMV/RPU).

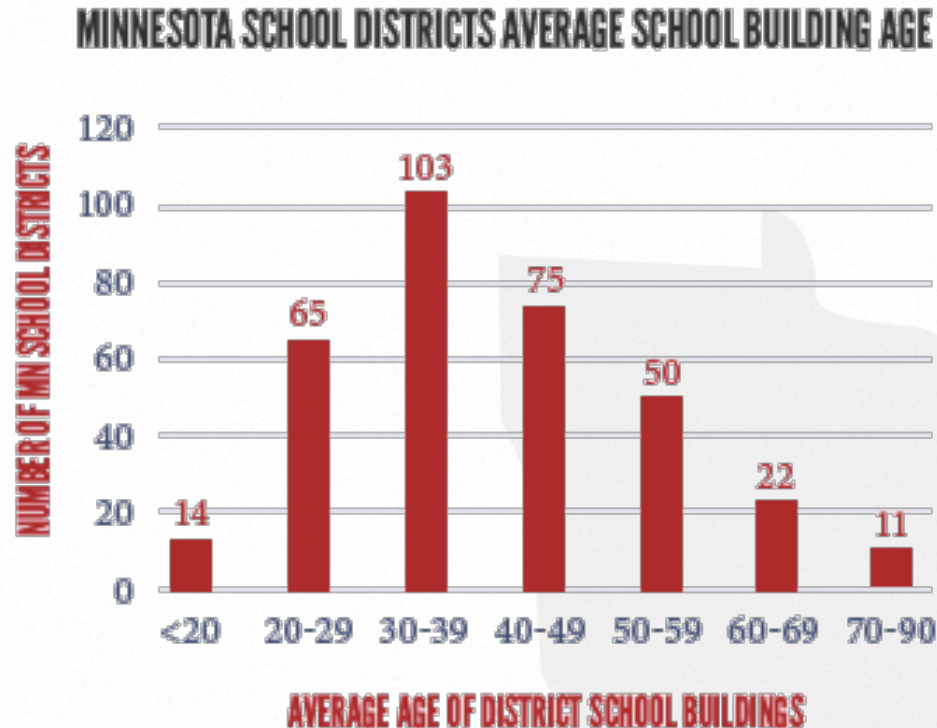

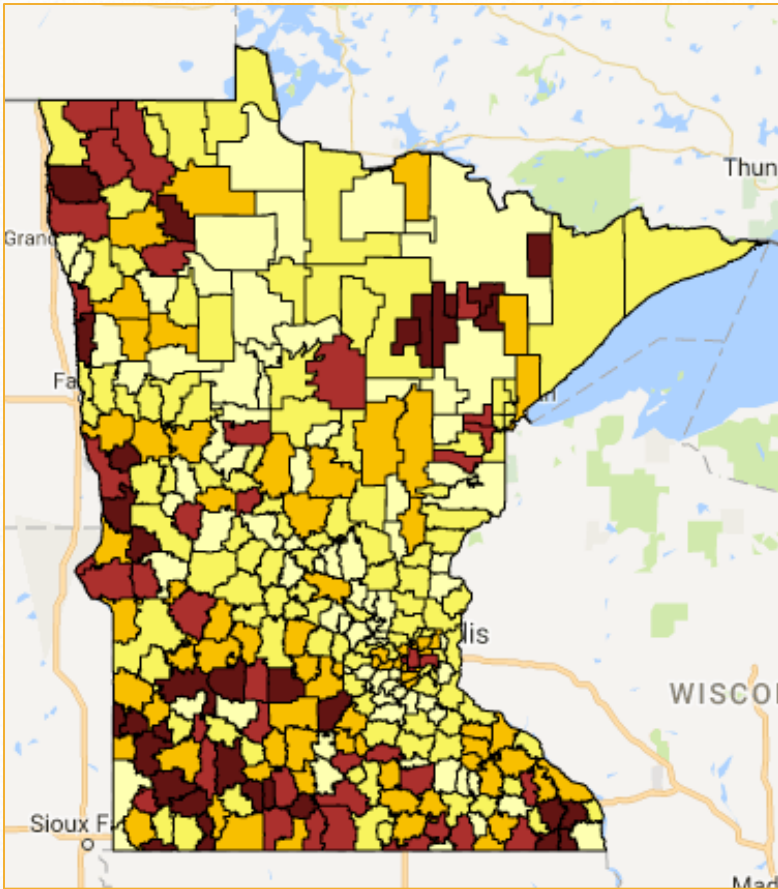

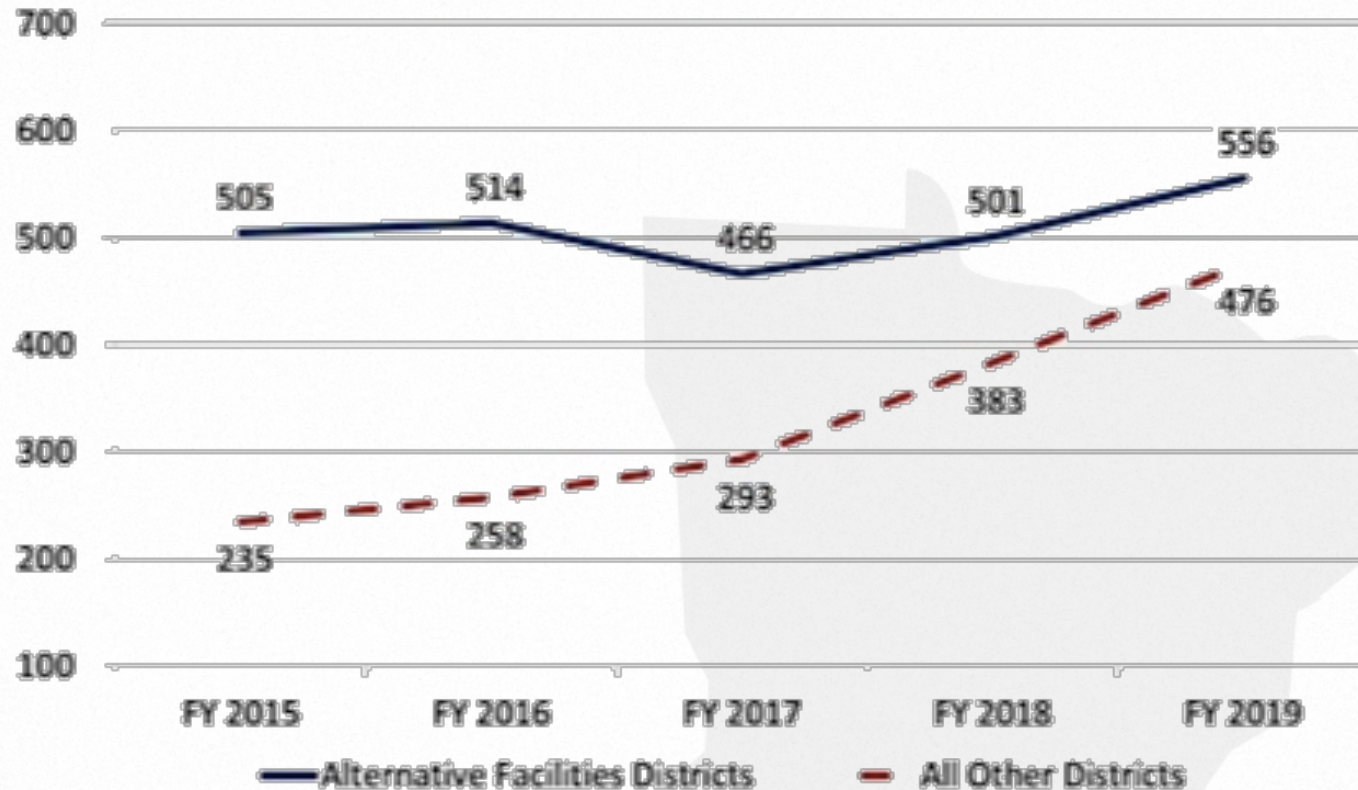


Rural bond elections

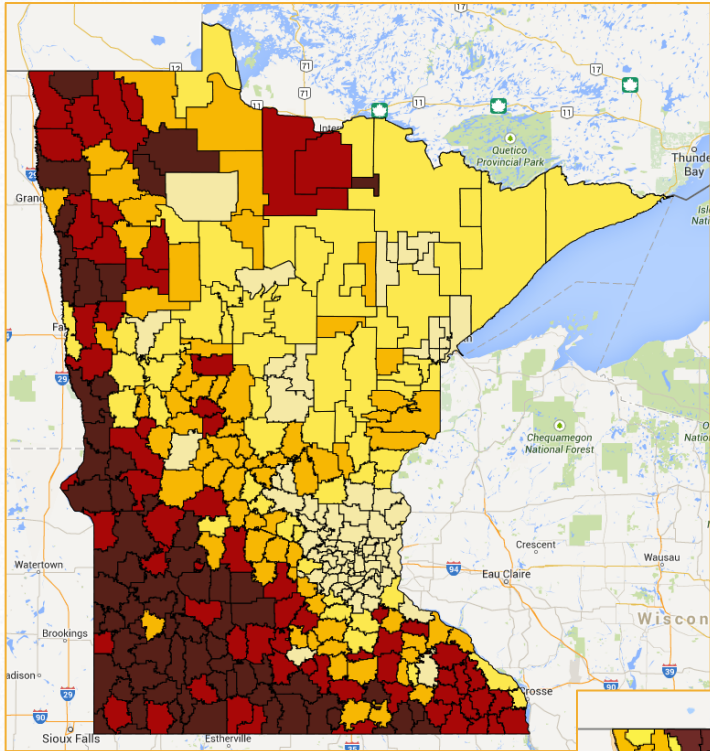
- Rural: 40% passed

Long Term Facilities Maintenance

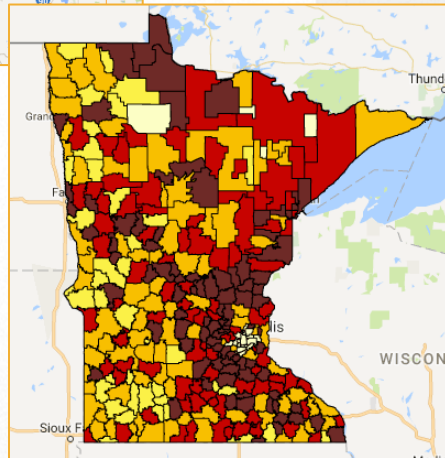
Districts Eligible for Alternative Facilities Revenue vs Other Districts



Ag2School for Fairer State Share



- Ag land is over 75% of TMV in 20% of districts (Brown)
(after class rates and exclusions applied)
- Ag land is 42-74% of TMV in 20% of districts (Red)
- Ag land is over 50% of TMV in one-third of districts

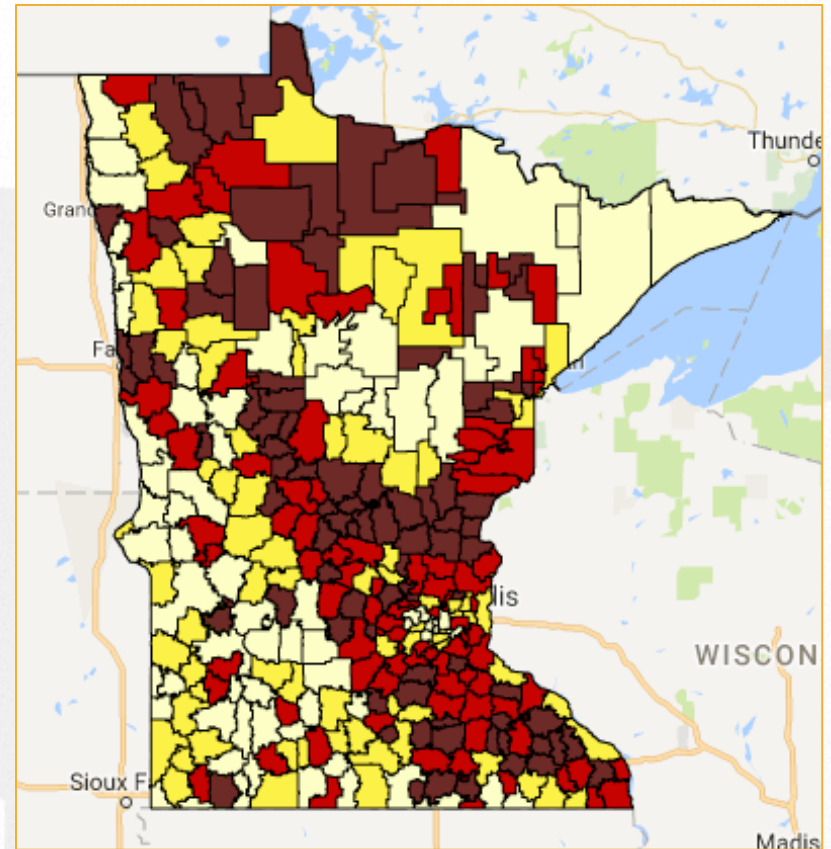


Map showing impact

Debt Service Equalization

Proposal

- Increase equalization to 100% of average ANTC
- Link equalization to average ANTC
- Reduce threshold for DSE to 12.5% of ANTC
